



## Do you know the origin of Valentine's Day?

Valentine of Terni, better known as Saint Valentine, was a monk who refused to submit to Emperor Claudius II the Goth. At the time, Emperor Claudius II wanted to ban marriage to prevent men from being tempted to stay with their fiancées rather than go off to war. Valentin de Terni continued to marry couples and defied the emperor's authority. He was imprisoned! It was here that he met his jailer's daughter: Julia, a blind girl.

She asked Valentin to describe the world to her. Through many encounters and exchanges, they fell in love, until a miracle happened: Julia regained her sight! This miracle was shared and relayed far and wide. So much so that Claudius II the Goth, who didn't like Christians, decided to condemn Valentin of Terni to death.

He then became a martyr, and was considered Saint Valentine by Pope Gelas I, who decided to honor the feast on February 14, 494.

The volunteer action center L'Actuel and the volunteer action center Soulanges will be accepting applications for their low-income tax clinic.

You can contact the volunteer action center Soulanges as of February 26, 2024 at 450 265-3134.

Eligibility criteria include income for 2023 not exceeding \$35,000 for a single person or \$45,000 for a couple or \$45,000 for an adult with one child. (\$2,500 for each additional child).

Interest income must be less than \$1,000.
